Devotions- Carol stated she would like to step down from the Devotions Chair by the Summer of 2024. Chapter names were listed and organized. A book is used for the devotions each week on Mondays. Pam mentioned she felt called to help with devotions. She would discern as such.

Funds- Pam gave out a worksheet and discussed the information of each fund. Stated she would need a replacement if she stepped up to become the Devotions Chair. Carolyn stated she would discern the call to help with Funds Chair.

Historian- Nancie gave out handouts from the IV Province in the Winter of 1996. It was titled, "A Few Thoughts on the Lord's Prayer." Read the prayer out loud. Also, there were historian guidelines on the DOK National website.

Communications-Gayle does the devotions for Province IV weekly. New members or updated contacts can sign up on the DOK National website.

Discussed Triennial 2024. They are planning to create approximately 800 welcome bags for the event. Each diocese is asked to bring 800 items representing themselves. Diocese of Tn is planning to bring bookmarks.

Gayle also maintains mass emails. She also provides Zoom meetings as needed.

Daughters at Large-Rebecca stated there are 3 new DALs to make 29 members in our diocese. She is trying to stay in contact (birthday, etc.) with all DAL members, however, contact information (updated phone number, new addresses, etc.) are not always being updated. Some DALs are behind on their dues.
