Pam Foster mentioned they are in the process of discernment for re-envisioning the Self-Denial Fund. There is a survey on the National website. They are looking to broaden outreach more than simply mission work. There is a minimum funding fee of \$25 which can be made on the website, but any amount can be donated. Checks are also acceptable.

A question was asked as to why we go to different chapters for the assemblies. Travel concerns were mentioned as some people were unable or unwilling to travel more than an hour to attend the assemblies. Rita Sue mentioned churches share the responsibility of the diocesan wide assemblies. Discussed the possibilities of taping and recording the services.

Rita Sue Warner discussed how five Daughters have died. Shelbyville had added two DOK members. St James the Less has plans to reinstitute their chapter.

The Diocese has a three-day leadership workshop with Bishop Glenda Currey.
